Registration and Travel Policies

1. All students registering for the first semester must apply for a Québec Acceptance Certificate (CAQ) and a study permit.
2. Students registering for the second semester of Secondary V cannot be guaranteed a place in the program.
3. Students entering Secondary V and wishing to receive their graduation diploma (DES) at the end of the current year will be obliged to complete and pass the Secondary IV History course during the school year. This course may require attending additional evening classes.
4. The Séminaire de Chicoutimi cannot guarantee that students will be registered with a certain group. This choice is left entirely to the International Student Program (ISP) office.
5. Because of the popularity of the International Student Program, the Séminaire de Chicoutimi cannot guarantee acceptance into the program.
6. The ISP department will do its best to accommodate special requests regarding the host family needs. The only time we can assure specific needs will be answered is when they pertain to allergies. Otherwise ISP students must accept all host family arrangements provided.
7. Arrival times:
 - Students should try to arrange flights for either a Friday or Saturday evening. In the event that the student arrives after 10:00 pm, during the week, he/she could be requested to stay at the airport hotel at his/her cost.
